TEACH US TO PRAY:

“Lead Us Not Into Temptation”



“I Need God’s Help To Avoid Temptation!”



“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”

- Matthew 6:13a

SAY:

Satan, our enemy, weaves a web of temptation in order to trap us into sin. Much of the time, if we are not careful and looking out for it, we will get caught in the trap of temptation and fall into sin. Satan is very crafty in his ways of trapping us. We must be aware of his schemes in order to avoid getting caught in the trap of temptation.

SHARE:

Together, with your family, go over the basic details of the story of Creation - especially the part of the story about Adam and Eve being tempted to sin. If you need a refresher on the story, familiarize yourself with it by reading through Genesis 1-3.

ASK/DISCUSS:

- What were the names of the two people God created first?
- How did Eve respond to Satan’s temptation?
- Did Adam follow Eve’s bad example?
- Did Satan tell Eve the truth?

SAY:

God has given us the ability to avoid being trapped in the temptation that Satan has laid out for us. We must pray for God’s wisdom daily, so that we will be led away from temptation’s trap and be delivered from the evil that so easily entangles us.

PRAY:

Pray that God will forgive each of you of your sin and set you free from the trap. Then, pray that God will lead and guide you each day to stay away from temptation and sin.
