1. The Guarantor better than any other! "We have such a high priest"... of Melchizedek. King and Priest.

God said so

4. How shall we respond to so great a covenant?

If anxious about your future accountability recall who your mediator is.

If discouraged about your past failings recall Jesus' words "It is finished"

Become an attentive learner since transforming knowledge is available (to all)

Submit as a servant in loving devotion to God and his work.

Repent and receive God's forgiveness, continuing in the freedom of Christ.

When you are hurting, run to Jesus in prayer, enjoying intimacy with the divine.

God's new covenant is free but it's not cheap. It cost Jesus his all, his very life, in obedience to arrange for your freedom. If you are not yet a follower of Christ and wish to accept the done deal of the new covenant in your life pray directly to God on the basis of Jesus' finished work. Admit you have failed to keep his laws. Confess your faults to God asking his forgiveness not only for your deeds, but the nature that leads to those choices. Accept his transforming presence to bring you under new management of the Spirit of God. Begin to seek him with all your heart and soul and come and meet your new brothers and sisters in his forever family. We will pray for you and walk with you on your new journey of Faith.
