Ezekiel 34:11 [NLT], Luke 15:3-6 [NLT]

**MAIN IDEA** || God takes the initiative and moves toward us; we take the initiative toward others.

God always makes the **first** move.

**Ezekiel 34:11–12 (NLT)** <sup>11</sup> "For this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I myself will search and find my sheep. <sup>12</sup> I will be like a shepherd looking for his scattered flock. I will find my sheep and rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on that dark and cloudy day.

1. We **pursue** each other because Jesus pursues us.

**Luke 15:3–6 (NLT)** <sup>3</sup> So Jesus told them this story: <sup>4</sup> "If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders. <sup>6</sup> When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.'

2. We listen to **understand** because Jesus listens to us.

The purpose in a man's heart is like deep water, but a man of understanding will draw it out. (Pr. 20:5)
