

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

We know many of you might be wondering what a Sunday Expression will look like. We hope these FAQs will provide you with the info you are looking for. If you have questions that are not answered here, please reach out to Dominic Kan (Lead Pastor), or any of the Missio Staff Team.

Will Missio be having an in-person Sunday Expression?

Yes. Starting Sunday, May 16, 2021, Missio will have an in-person Sunday Expression. The Expression will include live music, prayer, teaching from Scripture, and some (physically distanced) social interaction. Wearing masks and physical distancing will be required at all times. Coffee and refreshments will not be served during this time.

* To ensure our gatherings do not exceed 25% of capacity (per our Governor's guidelines for Multnomah County), each person (including children) is required to register before attending an in-person gathering. You can register [here](#).

Will there still be access to the Sunday Worship Expression online?

Yes. Our Sunday Expression will be a hybrid format, meaning there will be a Zoom Meeting option for people to still worship and engage online. Click [here](#) to join our Sunday Expression online.

Will everyone be required to wear masks during the Sunday Expression?

Yes. The CDC recommends all individuals 2 years old and above wear masks when gathering in public spaces.

Will Missio Kids classes be available during the in-person Sunday Expression?

No. Missio Kids classes will not be available at this time. However, kids are welcome to join the Sunday Expression with their family and will be provided with a "Missio Kids Expression Box" to encourage them in learning and growing as disciples of Jesus. Each child will have their own box (labeled with their first name) and a designated spot (by family last name) to pick up and drop off their box each week.

What other safety/cleaning measures are being taken during in-person Sunday Expression?

Seating in the worship center will be spaced out to maintain 6 feet of distance between individuals or family units. Seats in the worship center and other high use areas in the building (door handles, etc.) will be cleaned and disinfected before and after each gathering with disinfectant spray or wipes. There will be a oneway flow of traffic to enter and exit the worship center. Several exterior doors and windows will remain open during the Expression for fresh air flow. Touch-less hand sanitizer stations will be placed at entrances/exits and near other areas of high use.
