# PATIENCE

## Seeds for Harvest




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*Luke 8:15*

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“The seeds that fell into good, fertile soil represents those lovers of truth who hear it deep within their hearts. They respond by clinging to the word, keeping it dear as they endure all things in faith. This is the seed that will one-day bear much fruit in their lives” (TPT).

### Devotional

You not only have a seed in you, you are also a seed bearer. As believers, we are given to the ministry of reconciliation, so that by our example we might bring others to Christ. ### Study

Study and meditate on Galatians 6:8-9, “The harvest you reap reveals the seed that you planted. If you plant corrupt seeds of self-life into this natural realm, you can expect a harvest of corruption. If you plant the good seeds of Spirit-life you will reap beautiful fruits that grow from the everlasting life of the Spirit. And don’t allow yourselves to be weary in planting good seeds, for the season of reaping the wonderful harvest you’ve planted is coming” (TPT)!
