Creation all around testifies of God's reality. The grandeur of heaven alone has spoken to every tongue, every culture, and every society throughout history. Psalms 19:1-3 - The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language Where their voice is not heard.

Today's Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 NLT

9) for they keep talking about the wonderful welcome you gave us and **how** you turned away from idols to serve the living and true God. [10] And they speak of how you are looking forward to the coming of God's Son from heaven-Jesus, whom God raised from the dead. He is the one who has rescued us from the terrors of the coming judgment.

Introduction

Definition: personality is the characteristics and qualities that make a person noticeable or stand out.

Recounting verse 3, Paul says:

- You turned to God from idols, which is the work of faith
- You serve the living God, which is the labor of love
- You wait for His Son from heaven, which is the patience of hope

The idea of waiting does not infer apathy. In the Greek language, the word is used to describe what a mother does when she is anticipating the birth of her baby. She readies the nursery and eagerly prepares for his arrival. So, too, we should say, "Jesus is coming. I must make sure my family and friends are ready."

John 17:3 - And this is eternal life, that they know yoX

Jeremiah 10:10 - But the Lord is the true God; he is the living God and the everlasting King. At his wrath the earth quakes, and the nations cannot endure his indignation.

The Bible reveals God as personality. He is called "the living and true God" - One possessing self-consciousness and self-determination.

His personality is shown in what He does, such as:

- 1. God loves: John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- 2. **God hates:** Proverbs 6:16 - There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community.
- 3. God cares: 1 Pet 5:7 - Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
- 4. God grives: Gen. 6:6 - The Lord regretted that he had made human beings on the earth, and his heart was deeply troubled.

Only a personality can love, hate, care and grieve; therefore, God must be a living, eternal, personal being.
