Do you know about *Gifts in Time*? *Gifts in Time* is an electronic, pre-authorized giving program at St. John the Divine Anglican Church to help you conveniently, consistently and joyfully give your financial gifts to help our Church's ministry. Your offertory is simply withdrawn from your account (with your authorization of course!) and electronically transferred to St. John's account.
