"I'm Still Here"

In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me. (John 16:16)

- **1. Jesus set the example for the** necessity of the Holy Spirit. John the Baptist said in Mark 1:10: "I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."
 - Jesus was born of the Spirit. Matthew 1:18,20
 - After his water baptism he was empowered with the Spirit. Mark 1:9-15
- 2. Old Covenant to New Covenant Holy Spirit transition.

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. Ezekiel 36:26

- The Spirit is <u>only</u> able to live <u>inside</u> us because Jesus <u>crucified</u> the sinful nature. John 7:39
 - The disciples were born again after the <u>resurrection</u>. John 20:21-22
- 3. Jesus <u>prepared</u> his disciples for <u>receiving</u> the baptism of Holy Spirit. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high. Luke 24:49
 - The Father plans a new gift after Jesus leaves. John 14:26
 - This gift will enable you to live as if Jesus is still here. John 14:12
 - This baptism gives us the ability to witness for Jesus. Act 1:8
- **4. Have you received this <u>empowering</u> blessing?** If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more** will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him! Luke 11:13
