

Life Group Questions (Zechariah 6:1-8)

- 1. Read Zechariah 6:1-8 together. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind? What impacted you from the sermon?
- 2. Do you struggle with passages that seem to dwell on God's judgment? Why or why not?
- 3. One of the theological truths Pastor Andrew spoke about was that God's word is sure and true. He will do what he says he will do. Have you ever gone through a season of life where you doubted that? What were the circumstances going on? How did you come through that time?
- 4. The other theological truth is that God is Lord of human history. Everything works according to his will and plan. Do you find that frightening or comforting? Why?
- 5. One of the applications of these theological truths is that Jesus-followers need not avenge themselves. Read Romans 12:14-21 and 1 Peter 3:9-12. Do you find it hard to bless your enemies?
- 6. Think through times when evil was done to you. How did you respond? Why is repaying evil with good so difficult sometimes?
- 7. Does this mean Christians should be doormats? (ie. letting people walk all over them) How can you stand up for truth and justice but in a loving, gentle way?

Spend some time in prayer together. Thank God for his trustworthiness, sovereignty and justice. Ask for strength to not repay evil with evil. Repent of times when you've done this.
