

Church Family,

The last few years I've used our summer months to try and spark some evangelistic fervor in our congregation. I shared "5 Prayers for the Lost" last Sunday night. Tonight, I'll be sharing a similar message titled "3 Great Gospel Encouragements." Well, this week I came across an article titled, "10 Super Lame Excuses for not Sharing the Gospel." It's by an evangelist named Greg Stier.* It's all about reasons people give for why they don't tell others about Jesus. I don't have space to give you all 10, but I can share some of the highlights with you.

1. "I don't have the gift of evangelism." Yeah, well, I don't have the gift of mercy but I still should show it (Proverbs 14:21.)
2. "I don't know any lost people." If we want to be like Jesus and Jesus was a friend of sinners (Matthew 11:19), then we must be friends of sinners too.
3. "I don't know what to say." There are so many evangelism tools out there today this should not be an excuse.
4. "I just share the Gospel with my life and not my lips." Then you're like an airplane with one wing. We are called to do both!
5. "I don't want people to reject me!" Here's what Jesus said about that: "Whoever listens to you listens to me; whoever rejects you rejects me; but whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me" (Luke 10:16).
6. "I don't want to just give someone some forced evangelistic presentation!" Then don't! Have a Gospel conversation instead of giving them an evangelistic presentation. The goal is to engage them in a dialogue, not make them listen to your monologue!
7. "Evangelism doesn't work in a post-Christian culture." The Gospel always works (Romans 1:16).

Jesus told us in the Great Commission to "Go and make disciples" (Matt. 28:19). The Greek word for "go" is a participle and could read "as you are going..." In other words as we are going to work, to play, to school, to Starbucks, to the movie theater, to wherever...we should be making disciples.

As someone once said "It's the Great Commission not the good suggestion."
