

## **ASBURY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** **BUILDING USE POLICY - COVID-19 ADDENDUM**

### INTRODUCTION

The Church recognizes the significant impact Covid-19 has had on our church, congregation and community over the past year. As we begin to move towards a vaccinated community, modifications are needed to our previously enacted guidelines that provide normalcy for our guests and congregation.

It is the intent of Asbury United Methodist Church to remain in alignment with guidelines of the CDC and local authorities.

### MASKS

#### Indoors

Masks are not required to be worn while indoors so long as a person has been fully vaccinated for Covid-19 using either the Pfizer, Moderna or the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.

Masks are still required for people who are non-vaccinated while walking in and around church facilities. Masks may be taken off while seated at a socially safe distance of six (6) feet from non-family members.

#### Outdoors

Masks are no longer required for anyone on campus while they are participating in outdoor activities.

### Social Distancing

Our church congregation and community shall continue sitting at least six feet (3 feet for children 0-12) apart from others who are not a part of your immediate family or household while attending worship, Sunday School, or other indoor study's and meetings.

### Hand Sanitizer

The church has installed hand sanitizer stations throughout the campus. We encourage our members and guests to use hand sanitizer upon entry and exit of the facilities. Additionally, we welcome their use at any time our guests feel it is needed.

### Food

#### Preparation and Service

Food being prepared in or served on campus shall be done so in accordance with local food handling policies.

#### Meals

When sharing a meal with others, social distancing and masks are not required while seated.
