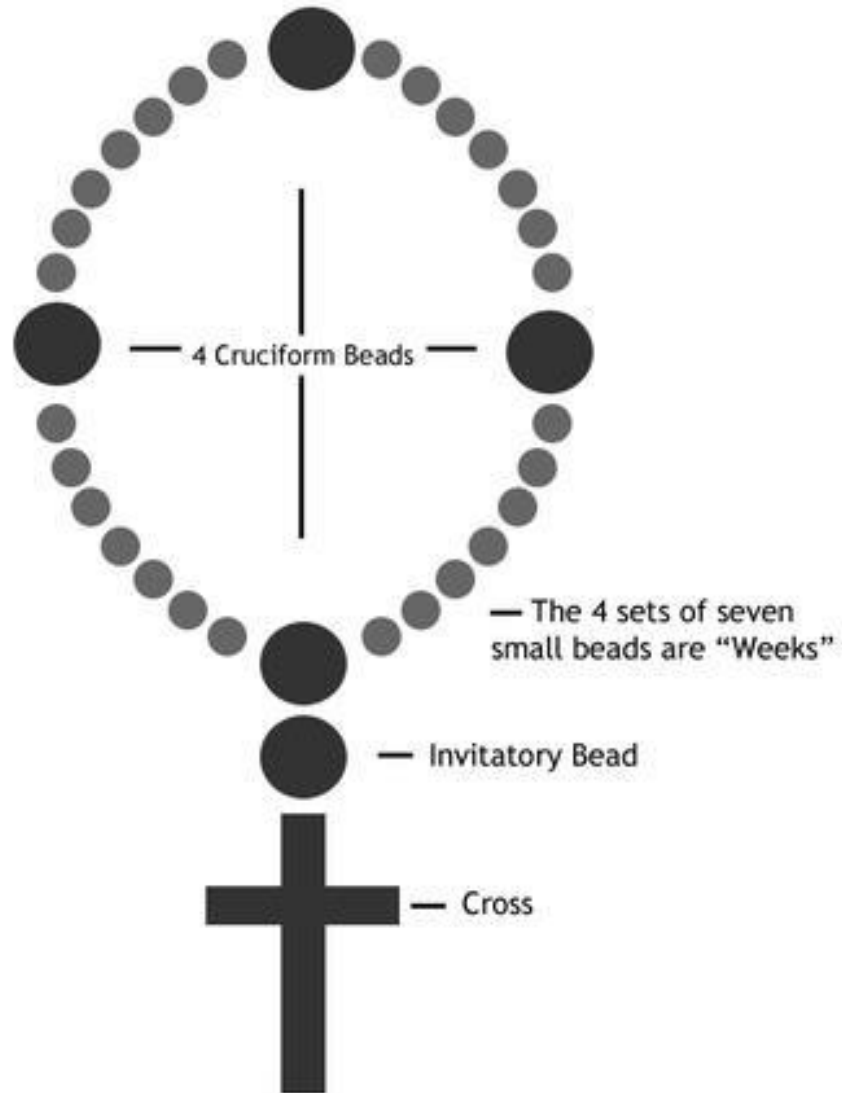

### **Ascension Rosary (with select verse from Hebrews)**

#### **Cross**

Grant, we pray, Almighty God, that as we believe your only-begotten Son our Lord Jesus Christ to have ascended into the heavens, so we in heart and mind may also ascend and with him continually dwell; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

#### **Invitatory (or Intention)**

### Pentecost Rosary

#### Cross

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

Romans 8:11

#### Invitatory (or Intention)

Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.  
As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be,  
world without end. Amen.

#### Cruciform

Jesus said, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, [...] You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

John 14:15-17

#### Weeks

### **Dismissary** (on the Invitatory bead)

God, who as at this time  
taught the hearts of your faithful people  
by sending to them the light of your Holy Spirit:  
grant us by the same Spirit  
to have a right judgement in all things  
and evermore to rejoice in his holy comfort;  
through the merits of Christ Jesus our Saviour. Amen.

### **Cross**

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.
