1.8 Election of Delegates at Parish Annual Vestry Meeting (Annual General Meeting)

1.8.1 Delegates to the Central Interior Assembly

Each parish may have 2 delegates and 2 youth delegates. Youth delegates shall be at least sixteen (16) years of age and not more than twenty-five (25) years of age at the date of his/her election. Youth Observers may attend Assembly and shall be at least fourteen (14) years of age.

Following the Parish Annual Vestry Meeting (Annual General Meeting), the parish must complete the *Certificate of Election* Form detailing information of elected delegates. The form is included in the package of information distributed to each parish prior to their Annual Vestry Meeting.

1.8.2 Indigenous Delegates

Prior to an Assembly all delegates attend, the Bishop will call for nominations of Indigenous Delegates.

In conjunction with the Bishop and the Territory Council of Indigenous Peoples, up to 15 First Nations delegates will be selected from the nominations, to attend Assembly with voice and vote.
