

## Resting in God's Kindness – TEXT: Proverbs 3:1-12

## Trust God's PATH HOME: Proverbs 3:5a, 7c

- 1) We come home to God BY both REPENTING AND by BELIEVING the Gospel of Jesus: Mark 1:15
- 2) We will not REPENT (CHANGE [*Meta-noeite*] our mind, heart, and life orientation [*nous*] TO GOD) UNLESS we TRUST God.
- 3) SIN is empowered by UNBELIEF: See Hebrews 3:12
- 4) Last week: TRUST God's WORD; CHARACTER; PERSPECTIVE; This week: TRUST God's SOVEREIGNTY; PROVISION; and DISCIPLINE

#### TRUST God's SOVEREIGNTY: Proverbs 3:6

- 1) God DOES whatever He PLEASES: Ps. 115:3. See: Ps 135:6; Dan 4:35
- 2) **God's PURPOSE SUCCEEDS regardless of OUR AGENDA**: Proverbs 19:21; See: Proverbs 16:9, 20:24; Jer. 10:23; Eph. 1:11; Heb. 6:17
- 3) God's PLANS and WAYS are usually DIFFERENT from and ALWAYS BETTER than OURS: Isaiah 55:8–9. See: 1 Cor. 2:9; Ephesians 3:20
- 4) God's AGENDA and WORKS are ALWAYS GOOD: Psalm 145:17
- 5) SO, WHY don't we just ENTRUST ourselves to Him? We...
  - a) BELIEVE the LIES (Romans 1:25) about ourselves & God
  - b) ARE spiritually enslaved REBELS: Titus 3:3. See: Romans 5:10
  - c) **Don't KNOW GOD or His WORD**: Matt. 22:29 See: Rom 1:19-21
- 6) We NEED a SAVIOR from our UNBELIEF who will...
  - a) Make Himself KNOWN: John 1:14, 18 See: Col 1:19-20
  - b) FREE us from our spiritual bondage to REBELLION: Col. 1:13-14
  - c) **RECONCILE us to God**: Colossians 1:19–22
  - d) LEAD us to HIMSELF in ALL CIRCUMSTANCES: John 17:3
- 7) NOW, we can ENTRUST ourselves to His SOVEREIGN...
  - a) LEADERSHIP: Psalm 23:1-2, 3b. See: Psalm 139:5-10, 24; 143:10
  - b) ACTIONS: Psalm 37:5. See also: Isaiah 64:4
  - c) PURPOSES: Romans 8:28. See also: Ezra 7:6, 8:22

### TRUST God's PROVISION: Proverbs 3:9-10

- 1) WHATEVER we HAVE, we were GIVEN: 1 Corinthians 4:7bc. See also: John 3:27; James 1:17
- 2) God DELIGHTS to give us GOOD GIFTS and PROVIDE for our NEEDS: Matthew 7:11. See also: Romans 6:25-26
- 3) God EXPECTS us to STEWARD His GIFTS for His GLORY: 1 Peter 4:10 See also: Luke 12:42; 1 Corinthians 10:31
- 4) God CALLS us to both RELATIONSHIP and WORSHIP through REPENTANT GIVING: Malachi 3:7b, 10a See also: Matthew 23:23
  - a) **He wants our BEST and FIRST**: Exodus 23:19a. See also: Exodus 34:26; Numbers 18:12; Nehemiah 10:35
  - b) **He does NOT want our LEFTOVERS**: 2 Samuel 24:24b See also: Malachi 1:6-9
  - c) A failure to GIVE is THEFT: Malachi 3:8
  - d) He PROMISES BLESSING to those who GIVE and CURSES to those who WITHOLD: Malachi 3:9-10
- 5) We can TRUST God to PROVIDE because He's ALREADY GIVEN us His BEST: Romans 8:32. See: 2 Corinthians 9:10-11
  - a) Our NEEDS: Philippians 4:19
  - b) Our DESIRES: Psalm 37:4 See: Psalm 34:10; 84:11
  - c) **ENOUGH for EVERY SITUATION**: 2 Cor. 9:8. See also: vs. 9-11
  - d) His KINGDOM: Luke 12:32
- 6) **SO, PURSUE HIM, FIRST**: Matthew 6:33

## TRUST God's loving DISCIPLINE: Proverbs 3:11-12

- 1) God has made us His CHILDREN through Jesus: Galatians 3:26. See also: Galatians 3:27-29, 4:6; John 1:12-13; Romans 8:14-16
- 2) **He LOVES and DELIGHTS in US!** 1 John 3:1a. See also: Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:9-10; John 3:16; Ephesians 2:4-10
- 3) **His love COMPELS Him to DISCIPLE US into His IMAGE**: Romans 8:29. See: Ephesians 4:15-16; 2 Corinthians 3:18
- 4) His GOAL in DISCIPLINE (instruction and correction) is our HOLINESS (being like Him): Hebrews 12:10–11. See also: vs. 5-9
- 5) He INTENDS for His BODY THE CHURCH to be PART of that DISCIPLESHIP: Hebrews 3:13. See also: Proverbs 27:17; Matthew 18:15-20, 28:19-20; 2 Timothy 4:2; Titus 1:13; Hebrews 10:24-25
- 6) REPENTANCE is OUR righteous response to His loving DISCIPLINE: Revelation 3:19. See also: Romans 2:4
- 7) WHEN we REPENT at His discipline, we will FIND GREATER GRACE and HIM: Hebrews 4:15-16. See also: Revelation 3:20

# "Gospel In Life" questions for REFLECTION & APPLICATION

1)	<b>BELIEVE:</b> WHAT TRUTHS did God REVEAL to me through His Word today about HIM and/or MYSELF?
2)	ASSESS: HOW do these truths ENCOURAGE and/or CHALLENGE (convict) ME?
3)	PROCESS: WHY is this message GOOD NEWS (GOSPEL) to ME today? (CONNECT the GOSPEL story to MY present story)
4)	<b>CHANGE:</b> WHERE will I APPLY (BELIEVE, REPENT, DO) this message in MY own life this week?
5)	PROCLAIM: WHO does God want ME to share these truths with?
6)	PREPARE for NEXT WEEK: Read Isaiah 58:1-14
