POLICIES AND GUIDELINES FOR RE-OPENING IN-CHURCH WORSHIP

JUNE 2, 2021

To limit the spread of COVID-19, we have implemented new safety policies and procedures that must be adhered to for the protection of all:

- No more than **50** congregants will be permitted to attend a given service.
- Registration will be on a first-come-first-served basis, through our website or by contacting the office. Registration will open one week in advance of a given service, opening at 9:00am Monday and closing at 3:30pm Friday. Only those who have successfully registered will be permitted to enter.
- **If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.** Anyone who currently has, has had, or has contacted anyone with, COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, will not be permitted to enter. Anyone who has been directed by Public Health to self-isolate will not be permitted to enter.
- Everyone is required to wear a mask, unless you have a medical condition that would prevent you from doing so.
- Everyone entering the building must sign in with their name and contact phone number. Temperature will be taken at entrance.
- Everyone within the building must respect social distancing measures and follow enter/exit/traffic flow signage as directed.
- Water dispenser will no longer be available. Drink or food sharing is not allowed.
- Seating will be arranged, please follow usher's direction, and do not change seats yourself.
- We encourage "silent singing," except worship leader, congregational singing is to be avoided.
- There is a limit of two persons in a washroom facility at a time.
- There will be formal sanitization done in between each service. In addition, sanitization supplies will be made available, should you wish to self-sanitize any shared equipment.
- Upon conclusion of the service, we ask that you promptly exit the building.
