## Minister's Message

Siblings in Christ,

I don't have a scripture quotation for you today, but I want to check in with you regarding a few things.

First, we are all excited by BC's restart plan and the prospect of the gradual removal of restrictions. In the Church we are especially excited at the renewed prospect of in-person worship. While Dr. Henry is now permitting in-person worship services of 50 people or less, that permission includes numerous caveats, such as physical distancing, pre-registration, contact tracing, no singing, etc.

Without limiting any decision your Church Board or Worship Committee may take in the next few months, currently my colleagues and I have no plan to resume in-person worship services in our own buildings until September.

This is partly because we are prioritizing your safety; some people cannot or will not receive the vaccine or wear masks, and we do not want to be responsible for even one COVID infection while the disease is still circulating. Nor do we want to be policing compliance and deciding who may or may not attend worship.

The other reason is logistical: a worship service has a tremendous number of moving parts, and reassembling that machinery, in addition to considering lessons learned and opportunities for improvement, will take time. We don't want to prepare to reopen, only to have a fourth wave shut things down again – as occurred around Easter.

Furthermore, and the second reason to check in with you: I will begin my six-week Sabbatical leave for summer school in about a month, on July 5th. The Rev. Michael Hare, to whom you have already been introduced in our Zoom worship services, will ably cover for my absence. This absence is part of my continued studies toward a Master of Theology degree and I expect that my courses – which this summer include a course on preaching without notes – will benefit our ministry together. As during my last Sabbatical, I will not be checking emails, performing pastoral visits, weddings, or funerals, or other ministry functions during that time.

That being the case, planning for in-person ministry only to have me leave for six weeks when we are ready to implement it does not seem advisable.

We are, however, looking into the possibility of an outdoor gathering if COVID restrictions permit it.

Thank you for your ministry, and for your continuing faithfulness in observing COVID restrictions. We are beginning to harvest the fruits – thanks be to God!
