



Indoor Service COVID Guidelines 06.04.21

The Medical Board of the Miami Valley Church have put together COVID guidelines for our indoor services starting this Sunday, June 6 at the Antioch Shriners building. These guidelines unless communicated will stay the same for future indoor services we will have.

You will find these guidelines much different from what we have implemented at our building since beginning to meet together on March 7th. We asks that everyone unite to the many scriptures that share the principal of consideration, humility and love.

Titus 3:1-2: 1 Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good, 2 to slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be gentle toward everyone.

Romans 12:3-5: For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. 4 For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, 5 so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

Ephesians 4:1-3: 1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. 2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. 3 Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Indoor Services starting on June 6:

Temperature Checks:

- There will be no temperature checks.
- If you or anyone in your household is feeling ill or has a fever, please stay home. You can still join us in the streamed service.

Seating for Service:

- There will be no more ushering to your seats
- But please fill the front row seats first

Masks:

- There will be no mask mandates, but please have personal masks on hand just in case
- If you prefer to wear a mask please feel free to do so, masks are fine
- Masks will still be available at the front door if you don't have one

Fellowship:

- No Social Distancing is mandated, but encouraged if the situation asks for it
- Fellowship after and before service can occur in the building downstairs or in the lobby
- Fellowship can continue outside too

Safety Guidelines:

- Hand Sanitizer will be available throughout the venue
- All chairs will be wiped down before service
- Communion & contribution will continue to be in the back, instead of trays being passed
