

Eunuch Sterile Celibate

By mistreatment - castration
Used to watch over the queen



Born a Eunuch • Born this way • Totally out of their control • No person's will



Made a Eunuch Outside of their decision Forced upon them • The will of the other person



Eunuch by Choice Chose to be celibate for God • Deliberate denial of desires • Full submission of their will to God JESUS

Jesus modeled all three sections of the analogy Born to die Mistreated by His own people Chose to submit



The question then becomes ... How will you choose to look at your situation?



Will you choose to see this as an opportunity to serve and experience God?

This even applies to our observance of communion



For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.
