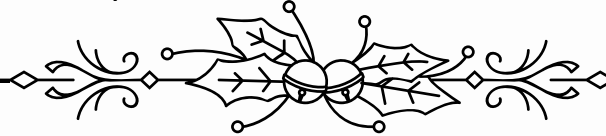

It's cold out there!

The Coldest Night of the Year is a walk that raises money and awareness towards the harsh winter conditions faced by our homeless neighbours. The Cloverdale Community Kitchen has been hosting CNOY since 2014 and has raised almost \$500,000! This year we are hoping to raise \$100,000 to help us in our efforts to alleviate poverty and food insecurity in our community.

Due to the COVID-19 global pandemic, there is also a virtual alternative to walking in person. Participants can choose to walk individually, or in their team bubbles, anytime in February on their own routes close to home. That being said, the Cloverdale community Kitchen will be putting safeguards in place to ensure that the event complies with all COVID restrictions. For example, there will be alternating start times to comply with all limit of assembly rules.
