How does it work?

Types of industry food accepted:

- Farms with excess/overage of crops
- Food from wholesalers
- Direct donations from retailers
- Slightly damaged foods
- Food that has been frozen on or before best before date

In BC, the Food Donor Encouragement Act protects corporations and their directors, agents, and employees from liability when donating food or distributing donated food.
