PASTOR'S MESSAGE - THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Friday, we celebrated the *Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus*, our Patronal Feast. Of all devotions, the Sacred Heart remains one of the most widespread and popular in the Church. That's because it reminds us of Jesus' undying love for all people, and the depth of his love and mercy for us.

But it isn't about Jesus' 'heart' or just an attribute of his. Understood in the light of Scripture, it includes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of his being. In other words, the 'Sacred Heart' *is* Jesus, the Word Incarnate, our Saviour, highlighting his love for the Father and for his brothers and sisters.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart is about contemplating him who was pierced (cf. Jn 19, 37; Zach 12, 10); contemplating the wounded side of Christ (cf. Jn 20, 27), from which flowed blood and water (cf. Jn 19, 34). It's a wonderful expression of the Church's love for Jesus, her Spouse and Lord, and *it calls for a fundamental attitude of conversion and reparation, of love and gratitude, of apostolic commitment and dedication to Jesus Christ and his saving work.* Jesus, who is one with the Father (cf. Jn 10, 30), invites his disciples to live in close communion with him and to model their lives on him and on his teaching.

That's why it was an essential component of Pope St. John Paul II's call for the new evangelization: "The faithful [need] to contemplate adoringly the mystery of Christ, the God-Man, in order to become men and women of interior life, people who feel and live the call to new life, to holiness, to reparation which is apostolic cooperation in the salvation of the world, people who prepare themselves for the new evangelization, recognizing the Heart of Christ as the heart of the Church: it is urgent for the world to understand that Christianity is the religion of love. [...] Contemplation of the Heart of Jesus in the Eucharist will... enable them to taste... the spiritual sweetness of charity at its very source" (Letter On the 100th Anniversary, no. 2).
