MAIN IDEA || We are pursued by God so that we can love and serve Him while we also care for others.

I will bring them back home to their own land of Israel from among the peoples and nations. I will feed them on the mountains of Israel and by the rivers and in all the places where people live. I myself will tend my sheep and give them a place to lie down in peace, says the Sovereign Lord. I will search for my lost ones who strayed away, and I will bring them safely home again. I will bandage the injured and strengthen the weak. But I will destroy those who are fat and powerful. I will feed them, yes feed them justice!

Why Do We Often Hesitate to Pursue Others?

- 1. We are (distracted) because we have so many things to pursue.
- 2. We are (**deceived**) and following the wrong map or the wrong person.
- 3. We (**delay**) in making a decision because it will cost us something.

What Should We Do?

1. We should (imitate) God.

"Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God." **Ephesians 5:1-2 [NLT]**

- 2. We should be more (intentional) about caring for others by focusing on Him and others.
- 3. We should (act) on the instructions of our creator as he directs us to one-another.

I CAN ONLY IMAGINE!

Imagine if we were to consistently:

- (<u>love</u>) one another.
- (serve) each other.
- (encourage) one another.
- (carry) burdens for others.
- (pray) for one another.

Why We Need to Act

- 1. Others will (**know**) God because of how you love one-another.
- 2. We will (avoid) self-inflicted hurts & pains.
- 3. We will (**help**) others in their walk with God.
- 4. We will Finish Strong and (leave) a Godly legacy that impacts those within our sphere of influence.
