3. Name at least five attributes of God that come to your mind. (Hint: Isaiah 46:9-10, Psalm 139, Psalm 24:8, James 1:17)
4. How often do you take the time to consider what benefits you have received from the Lord? Name some "benefits" from the Father that have been accrued to you.
5. Read Luke 7:36-47. What are your thoughts around Jesus' words about sin and forgiveness, especially in v. 47?
6. Why is it impossible for people to earn their salvation on their own merits? See Ephesians 2:1-10
7. How can it be that we have all we need from the Lord and yet we aren't quite finished yet?
