NATIONAL INDIGENOUS HISTORY MONTH

As National Indigenous History Month unfolds, we are invited to celebrate the culture and contributions of First Nations, Metis and Inuit people in this land, and encouraged to learn more about their experiences.

The recent discovery of the remains of 215 children in unmarked graves at the Tk'emlúps (Kamloops) Indian School has been particularly affecting. In response to this discovery, we received this [Pastoral Letter from Bishop John](#), which you are invited to read. By the Bishop's request, this letter was read aloud in every church of the Diocese of New Westminster on June 6th. Bishop John's letter includes links to further reading, and includes the information that Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc is now accepting donations for further work.
