SERIES OVERVIEW

When we call ourselves followers of Jesus, or Christians, we can't just say we follow Jesus, and not live like it. We must *show* it by how we live. Living for Jesus means living a different way, following in the way of Jesus as we understand it in Scripture, and as we work it through in community, the church. Our life, our words, and our actions must line-up with the label: Jesus-follower.

1 | Ask

Ask your child:

2 | Read

INSTRUCTIONS

Read James 5:13-15.

Ask your child:

- What's that all about? What does it mean?
- Who are people we do those things with?

3 | Watch

INSTRUCTIONS

Watch the video teaching with your family this week. Talk about the video as a family.

- What stood out to you?
- What did you like?
- What did you want to ask a question about?

(Tip: If it's helpful, consider pausing the video as you watch it together, and ask questions or talk about things that stick out to you as you go!)
