RETURN-IT-EXPRESS - Save those holiday beverage containers!

Bring your beverage containers to a return-it-express and raise money for the church.

1. Bag clean unsorted beverage containers (not milk products) in a clear or blue recycling bag
2. Make sure the bag is not too heavy (about 12 bottles per bag to avoid breaking)
3. Print a label at the bag label kiosk – our “code” is the church phone number: 604-224-3238
4. At the Return-it Express station – drop off your bags & go!
5. They sort the containers and credit the St Philip’s Account
