Oh Taste & See!



Psalm 34:8

“O taste and see that the Lord [our God] is good; How blessed [fortunate, prosperous, and favored by God] is the man who takes refuge in Him” (AMP).

Devotional

Taste and see that the Lord your God is good. He invites us in to see His goodness. See James 1:17, “Every gift God freely gives us is good and perfect, streaming down from the Father of lights, who shines from the heavens with no hidden shadow or darkness (The implication is there is nothing that you will find wrong with God, nothing in him that could even remotely appear to be evil hiding. The more you get to know him the more you realize how beautiful and holy he is) and is never subject to change” (TPT).

This world has nothing that can truly satisfy our souls desire. Everything we experience outside of the presence of the Father is temporary. It seems good for a moment, but quickly fades away. Recklessly seek Him and watch the desires of your heart change and align with Him.

Study

Spend time this week studying Matthew 7:7-8 (AMP), “Ask and keep on asking and it will be given to you; seek and keep on seeking and you will find; knock and keep on knocking and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who keeps on asking receives, and he who keeps on seeking finds, and to him who keeps on knocking, it will be opened.

Reflection & Action

- Ask for the Lord to reveal His goodness to you.
- Are you taking refuge in Him? What does this mean to you personally?
- Refresh your thoughts and mind-sets by asking, seeking and knocking.
