

Travelling off-campus in a shared vehicle while at the Sorrento Centre:



Safe travel: Sorrento Centre guests may travel in shared vehicles for day trips. The driver of the shared vehicle will be responsible for ensuring a safe and healthy trip.

Limit on capacity: Do not fill the vehicle to capacity. If necessary, make two trips or arrange for additional shared rides. Leave the middle seat in bench seating vacant, unless it is a family.



Masks and hand sanitizer: Please wear a mask before entering a shared vehicle and keep the mask in place for the entire trip. Face masks are available at the Sorrento Centre office. Please use hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer is available at the Sorrento Centre office.



Follow all protocols: Please follow all health protocols at your destination, and at any stops along the way. The driver will be responsible for alerting passengers to protocols.

Cleaning, sanitizing: Drivers will be responsible for cleaning and sanitizing high-touch surfaces in their vehicles before and after any shared activities. Disinfectant wipes are available from the Sorrento Centre office.
