

Safety Procedures for In-Person Events and Services

July 1st, 2021

We want to ease any nerves and make our gatherings as safe as possible. We do not just want to appear safe; we want to be safe!

Sanitation/High Touch Surfaces

All common and high-touch surfaces will be wiped down by the custodial team and volunteers prior to and following an in-person gathering, and people will be encouraged to wash their hands or sanitize frequently.

Sanitization Stations

There will be sanitization stations available throughout the church building.

Face Coverings

All visitors, staff and volunteers *12 years and up* will be **encouraged** to wear a face covering as they enter the building.

What if I am sick?

We encourage you to contact us through the office or join us for services online if you are displaying any symptoms of communicable diseases such as CO-VID 19, influenza, or the common cold.

Food Service

Food service will be self-serve for the time-being. People will be encouraged to wash or sanitize their hands before and after eating.

Physical Contact

Please continue to limit contact wherever possible.

Giving

The collection plate will not be passed during the service, but there will be a dedicated collection box at the church entrance for in-person worship services. Giving is also available through our website.

Communion

Communion will be provided in a single-use container upon arrival at the church building. Visitors will be asked to dispose of their cup in garbage cans upon exiting the sanctuary.

Please encourage those around you to respect the decisions and directions of volunteers to ensure a safe and fun event!
