

# Living and Growing in FAITH



Romans 10:17 shares that faith comes from hearing God's word:  
So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard  
comes through the word of Christ. (NRSV)  
So faith comes from hearing, that is,  
hearing the Good News about Christ. (NLT)  
Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the  
message is heard through the word about Christ. (NIV)

Let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us,  
looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.
