Threshold Ministries exists to bring anyone, no matter what their background, into a living relationship with Jesus and his people.

Threshold Ministries is looking for an Outreach Worker to manage and operate the Street Hope Victoria Outreach.

Street Hope Victoria is a volunteer-driven Christian organization that builds personal relationships with people who face multiple barriers and marginalization and encourages them to seek wholeness in all aspects of their lives. These people may be facing poverty, a lack of supportive community, homelessness, addictions or mental health issues.

Street Hope Victoria operates out of a motor home, which is parked in downtown Victoria on a couple of weekday evenings. Volunteers welcome people into the motor home and serve them homemade soup, sandwiches, hot chocolate, juice, cookies and fruit.

We feed hungry people, provide essentials such as warm clothing and toiletries, establish and nurture meaningful connections with folks, and encourage them towards healing in their lives.

The successful candidate will

- Have knowledge of the challenges faced by homeless people
- Be passionate about working with vulnerable people.
- Be committed to outstanding service
- Have the ability to work without judgement or prejudice with people from a variety of backgrounds
- Agree with the Statement of Faith of Threshold Ministries.

Responsibilities of the position include

- Organizing, training and recruiting volunteers.
- Coordinating supplies and food for the evening outreach.
- Staying current with the issues in the street community and the services available locally
- Partnering with others/organizations who share our values.
- Working as a team with volunteers and committee members.
