# The reward is also found in the labor:

Being in the vineyard Working for the owner Clear expectations Safe

#### A change in perspective:

Do the eleventh-hour workers gain more by working less? (-) Do the early workers gain more? (How)

Money, experience, being in the vineyard?

#### This is a perspective change:

I have to work - <u>I get to work</u>
I have to do right - <u>I get to do right</u>
I have to endure hardships - <u>I get to endure hardships</u>

I deserve more - <u>I am good with</u> whatever

# The reward should be more for the workers who were there longer.

I have been saved longer and endured more, therefore I deserve more!

Leverage what we have been given
