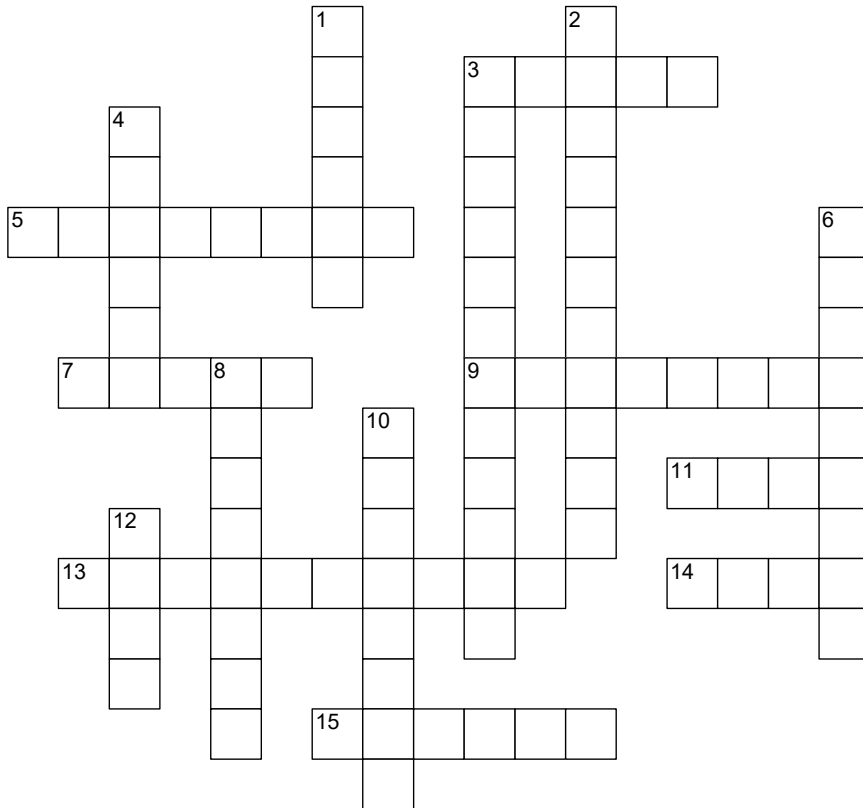


Ephesians Cross-Word

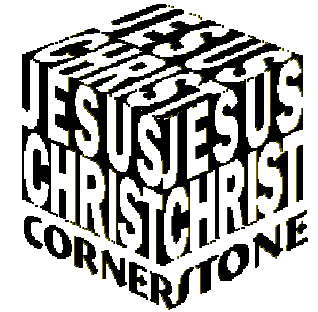

Today's lessons:

2 Samuel 7:1-14a

King David feels guilty about living in a palace while God still has no house (= temple). But God makes it clear to David that it's not up to him to build God a house; on the contrary: God will build David a house that will last forever (meaning in this case a dynasty). God promises King David that he will stand by him and keep his covenant with him forever. Always there will be a descendent of David on the throne. (A promise we see fulfilled in Jesus Christ.)

Psalm 89:20-37

Ephesians 2:11-22

God has brought down the dividing wall between Jews and non-Jews through Jesus Christ. In him (that is: in the Church) God has made for himself one people out of the two groups that used to be so different. But this whole construction of the Church is possible only because Jesus Christ serves as its cornerstone.

Mark 6:30-34, 53-56

Wherever Jesus and his disciples go, people recognize them and expect great things from them.
