

## STUDENT HEALTH

### Rationale

To promote the health of students, CISVA works with the Ministry of Health, the medical health professionals of Vancouver Coastal Health and Fraser Health Authorities.

### Policy

In accordance with the BC Health Act (Schools) CISVA schools are required to be free of all tobacco and vapour products both within and on school premises.

### Smoke and Vapour Product-Free Environments

The *Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act* prohibits all persons from smoking or using tobacco, or holding lighted tobacco in a school building.

All vehicles and grounds shall be smoke and vapour product free.

A person must not smoke or use tobacco, or hold lighted tobacco, or be in possession of a vapour product device in or on St. Francis de Sales School property.

A person must not use an e-cigarette, or hold an activated e-cigarette, in or on St. Francis de Sales School property.
