

St. Paul's Plan to Reopen for Public Worship

Parish Council has set Aug. 8 as the date for us to resume in-person Services (assuming the Provincial reopening plan stays on track).

There won't be a limit on numbers, but "distancing" pictures will be placed on alternating rows of pews, which will limit seating to 100.

No registration will be required.

Mask-wearing will be mandatory for the month of Aug. (in keeping with the city bylaw), and then re-evaluated. Singing will be allowed with masks on (this is set by the Diocese). The choir will be recorded music.

There will be no Coffee Time in-person during the month of August but we will continue to meet on Zoom.

In-person Sunday School will resume in Sep.

The Services will continue to be live-streamed.

Sunday, September 12 we will resume with 2 services at 8:30 and 10 a.m. We will need to have help with cleaning between service in order to do this. Coffee Time will begin again on this Sunday.
