	<p>a. <u>Parish Council Expansion Fund Proposal</u> – Discussion about the fact that we have over \$26,000 set aside in an Expansion Fund that may never be needed, but we do have upcoming Capital Improvement needs (such as replacing our furnaces). Doreen Peters moved that we transfer all of the money in the Expansion Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund. Seconded by Annette Pingot. Carried.</p> <p>b. <u>Update on Telus Proposal</u> - Laura O'Neill provided an update on the proposal from Telus to install a Cell Tower on our property. A task force was struck in the fall to review the proposal, and we are now waiting to hear back from Telus.</p> <p>c. <u>Task Force for St. Paul's Missional Footprint</u> – Fergus gave a brief explanation on what the Diocese is asking us to do and is looking for volunteers to work on a task force. An information document from the Diocese will be posted on the website.</p> <p>d. <u>Update on Benches</u> – Donations have been made in the past towards the purchase and installation benches around the property. Volunteers are needed to sit on a task force to make a decision on the number of benches we can purchase and where they should be installed.</p> <p>e. <u>Selling of movable sign and letters</u> – As we no longer use our old movable sign, Kathleen Robinson moved that we sell the movable sign and letters. Seconded by Annette Pingot. Carried.</p>
