# FAITHFULNESS

## The Assurance




---

*Hebrews 11:1*

---

“Now faith is the assurance (title deed, confirmation) of things hoped for (divinely guaranteed), and the evidence of things not seen [the conviction of their reality—faith comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses]” (AMP).

### Devotional

Faith is our assurance. Assurance is defined as, “a positive declaration intended to give confidence”. Faith is our confidence, confirmation, title deed of things hoped for and divinely guaranteed; it is also the evidence of things not seen. Faithfulness is acting on your faith relationship to the Lord. Walking out your faith is tapping into His Faithfulness. Just as Abraham did, see Galatians 3:6 (TPT), “Abraham, our father of faith, believed God, and the substance of his faith released God’s righteousness to him”.

Stand and do not be shaken. Believe without seeing by your physical eyes. And be assured that the testing of your faith produces endurance and let endurance have its perfect result so that you are lacking nothing (James 1:3-4).

### Study

Spend time meditating on James 1:3-4. “Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace]. And let endurance have its perfect result and do a thorough work, so that you may be perfect and completely developed [in your faith], lacking nothing” (AMP). As you meditate, reflect on what the Holy Spirit reveals to you.

### Reflection & Action

- How can you tap into your faith this week and access His Faithfulness?
- Reflect on the assurances/promises the Lord has spoken over your life.
