## NEWS IN RESTORATIVE JUSTICE

A recent British Columbia-based <u>research</u> <u>study</u> found that the involvement and commitment of a community is central to the growth and use of Restorative Justice (RJ) in that community. Community

involvement"central" rather is than "periphery". This includes collaboration residents, schools, community between programs, and governmental bodies. In addition, the researchers stress that further learning about RJ is necessary, specifically regarding the role of traditional Indigenous justice practices in RJ.
