

Covid-19 Safety Protocol for Brechin House – July 15, 2021

1. Staff who are experiencing the symptoms of a communicable disease are asked to stay home, and work from home if they are well enough to do so. Anyone experiencing symptoms of a communicable disease is asked to avoid coming to Brechin House until their symptoms have subsided.’

2. Staff persons and visitors who are not 2 weeks post second vaccination will continue to wear masks in the common areas inside the building. Staff persons are free to work alone in their own office without a mask. People who are fully vaccinated may choose not to wear masks.
3. A sign-in sheet shall continue to be maintained for anyone other than Cindy, Tif and Christine.
4. When using the washroom facilities, each person shall wipe down the surfaces that they have touched as they leave the room.
5. The doors to Brechin House shall remain locked at this time. A sign on the door will inform people that they need to ring the doorbell for staff to let them in. This is to ensure that we continue to have a record of persons entering the building and ensure that the number of persons in the building remains at safe levels.
6. Drop in visits are welcomed without a need for prior appointments. If there are too many persons in the building, some people may be asked to wait outside in order to maintain safe distancing.
7. A distance of 2 m. shall be maintained as possible, and handshaking or hugging is prohibited for the near future.
8. Small group gatherings of up to 6 people may take place in the living room of Brechin House. Any attendees who are not fully vaccinated must wear a mask. Attendees are asked to bring their own refreshments, if desired, and refrain from using the kitchen. The washroom facilities are available, and each person must wipe down the surfaces they have touched as they leave the washroom.
9. Small group gatherings of up to 10 people may take place on the lawn without masks, maintaining a distance of 2 m. Attendees are asked to bring their own refreshments, if desired, and refrain from using the kitchen. The washroom facilities are available but are to be accessed via the back stairs to reduce possible contact with those in the building, and each person must wipe down the surfaces they have touched as they leave the washroom.
