GUIDELINES FOR RESUMING IN PERSON SMALL GROUP/FELLOWSHIP

JULY 2021

Since the Province announced the Stage 3 Restart Plans on July 1, we are no longer under capacity limits or restrictions on indoor or outdoor religious gatherings and worship services. As much as we enjoy the relieve, we will continue to be vigilant and exercise reasonable measures to prevent virus spread.

Please consider the following guidelines as you start to resume in-person small group or fellowship gatherings especially when using church facilities:

- 1. Unless room or space of your activity has been assigned in advance, all bookings (including the parking lot) be requested through office via email at info@westwoodac.org.
- 2. **Masks** wearing is **highly recommended** for any indoor gatherings except for children under the age of two or those who have medical conditions that prevent them from doing so.
- 3. **Masks** wearing while singing or having activities that require active motions is **highly recommended** especially when not all attendees are full vaccinated.
- 4. No food or beverages should be offered to or provided by event leaders unless special arrangements have been made, e.g., individually packaged snacks. Participants may bring their own personal beverage or food for their own consumption. Potluck or food sharing is not encouraged until further notice.
- 5. If any member of the participants household or social group is sick, or thinks they might be sick, they should not be spending time, in person, with others. People who have symptoms should refer to the COVID-19 testing information to determine if testing is necessary and follow self-isolation guidelines.
- 6. Practice good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. Sanitize or wash hands when entering and exiting the church building.

We will entrust the event leaders to ensure participants following the safety policies and practices for their gathering. Thank you for your cooperation.
