






Bible Mystery #29:


Clue: Joshua 6:5

Bible Mystery #30:

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! These problems are like labyrinths. Gideon did not feel equipped to be a judge of Israel. He wondered at God's choice of him. But his faith grew as God went before him. Once God asked him to defeat an army so big it looked like a "swarm of locusts." Only God sent two-thirds of Gideon's army home first. Then, he sent home most of the 10,000 remaining – except for a mere 300 soldiers. It was with this handful of men that Gideon defeated the huge enemy army. Follow Gideon has he goes through the labyrinth of not believing in himself to believing the God of Israel is powerful enough to lead him in destroying an army the size of a locust swarm.
