READ TOGETHER //

James 3:1-9

If you're reading this with others, have someone read it aloud, then have someone else summarize what James is saying in this passage.

DISCOVER TOGETHER //

What does this passage reveal about God?

What does this passage reveal about us as Humans?

What does this passage reveal about the way our World works?

What does this passage specifically invite you to do this next week?

DISCUSS TOGETHER //

If you could have a conversation with James about what he wrote in James 3:1-9, what would you ask him or say to him?

Why does James say not many people should become teachers?

Does this change the way you think about who should teach and who shouldn't?

Why do you think controlling the tongue (or our words) is so difficult?

What is something you can do this week to better control your words (examples: think before speaking, counting to 10, surround yourself with sources that speak encouraging words, etc)
