Acknowledgment of these terms and agreement to abide by the rules is given upon use of amenities.

Swimming Pool

Pool use is reserved for registered guests of Miracle Manor

- No lifeguard is on duty. Swim at your own risk.
- Pool Hours
 - o 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM.
 - o The Pool will be locked during off hours.
- No one under the age of 16 is allowed to be in the pool area without supervision from a parent or legal guardian.

Swimming Attire:

- Modest bathing suits are requested.
- Please wear a bathing suit cover or t-shirt to and from the pool.
- No smoking, pets, food, beverages, foul language, running, horseplay, or diving is permitted in the pool enclosure.
- Please deposit your trash and debris in the appropriate receptacles.
 - We are surrounded by beautiful natural habitats and strive to keep the grounds free from trash.

Pool Towels

- Pool towels are available at the front desk.
- Unreturned pool towels will incur a \$20 replacement fee per towel.

Canoe Rentals

The Manatee River offers much to explore and one of the best ways to experience the mesmerizing natural habitat is in a canoe.

Canoe rentals are \$20 up to 3 hours. To rent a canoe, please see the front desk.

Guests under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult, legal guardian, or parent. This adult will have to sign the waiver and assumes responsibility for the lives trusted to them during the extent of the canoe excursion. Please bring the identification of adult who is signing the waiver to the front desk when renting the canoe. The ID will be held with the waiver and returned when you have completed your adventure.

All participants MUST wear a life vest per the U.S. Coast Guard.

We suggest that canoe trips be started no later than two hours before sunset.

Please complete your trip 30 minutes prior to sunset to avoid being stuck on the river in the dark.

 There are times in the evenings that the water management authorities choose to release the pressure at the reservoir up river and this can cause a sudden rush of water to flow downstream.

We suggest anyone interested in taking a canoe trip be somewhat experienced in paddling a canoe and to also look up the tide times. This can determine which direction you head first, with or against the flow.

Shuffleboard & Horseshoe Court Rules

- Shoes must be worn at ALL TIMES.
- NEVER walk on court. Walk in end zones and between courts only.
- Courts can be very slippery at all times.
- Small end of cue is to be used to move the disc.
- No bicycles, skateboards or any kind of roller skates are allowed inside the fenced area surrounding the shuffleboard courts.

The horseshoes are stored in the shuffleboard cabinet.

- They are to be played outside the fenced area in the grass.
- All horseshoes are to be returned to the shuffleboard cabinet when done using them.
- No children are allowed to play unless there is an adult or responsible 18 or older person with them throughout the entire game.
- Key must be signed out and in at the front desk.

Basketball, Volleyball and Tennis Courts

- Equipment can be checked out at the front desk.
- Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- No bicycles, skateboards, or roller skates on the tennis courts.
- No pets allowed on any courts.
- If the volleyball or tennis court nets are damaged, participants must report this to the front desk prior to using.
- Courts are open until dusk.

The first-floor deck closes at 8PM.

Miracle Manor Quiet Hours begin at 11PM.

Dining Room

Agape Gardens is located just beyond the main entrance to Miracle Manor by the Gazebo and Pond.

Gift Shop

Book and gift shop is located in the Resource Center in the Tabernacle Lobby. The gift shop is open before and after services.

Housekeeping

If you need extra towels, toilet paper, pillows, blankets, etc. please ask the front desk. Personal items such as toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, razors, and feminine products are available at the front desk for a small fee.

Ice and Vending Machines

Located on the first floor between the lobby and hallway rooms, the ice machine is only for servicing the ice bins in your guest room. Please do not fill coolers. 10lb bags of ice are available for purchase at Wawa, Publix, and other convenience stores.

Manatee River

The Manatee River is a 36-mile-long river in Manatee County, FL. The river forms in the northeastern corner of Manatee County and flows into the Gulf of Mexico at the southern edge of Tampa Bay. Wildlife in and around the river includes alligators, herons, manatees, dolphins, turtles, and fish such as bass, bluegill, catfish, and gar. Bull sharks are occasionally found in the brackish water near its low-lying outlet. At Christian Retreat, we enjoy having a lagoon which is fed by the river. You may spot a friendly manatee feeding there, or in rare cases, an alligator. Florida law prohibits feeding or bothering either.

Manatee Village Historical Park

Visit the county's first courthouse, original settler's home, Wiggin's store, a schoolhouse, and more, 604 15th Street East, Bradenton, 941,749,7165.

Marie Selby Botanical Gardens

Visit world renowned Marie Selby Botanical Gardens nestled in downtown Sarasota. 811 S. Palm Avenue, Sarasota. 941.366.5731.

Mote Marine Aquarium

Explore the secrets of the sea through touch pools, viewable working labs and high-tech interactive exhibits that showcase the world-renowned research of Mote Marine Laboratory. See sharks, manatees and sea turtles, along with more than 100 other species of marine life.

Myakka River State Park

One of Florida's oldest and largest, the Myakka River flows through 45 square miles of wetlands, prairies, and woodlands. Hiking, fishing, camping, biking, and wildlife observation are available. South on I-75 to exit 205 and west on S.R. 72 to Myakka State Park Road.

Ringling Art Museum

Located at the end of University Parkway on Tamiami Trail, the Ringling Art Museum include the John and Mable Ringling House "Ca'd'Zan", Circus Museum, lush gardens, and the historic Asolo Theater.

Riverwalk

A 1.5 mile park overlooking the Manatee River, ADA-accessible. Spanning downtown Bradenton, the Riverwalk includes family fun zone and splash pad, playgrounds, beach volleyball, skatepark, fishing pier, canoe launch and more. 452 3rd Ave West, Bradenton.

Sarasota Classic Car Museum

Is recognized as the second oldest continuously operating antique car museum in the Nation. As you stroll through the museum, travel back in time and into the future of man's greatest invention, the automobile. Antique, exotic, European and one-of-a-kind classics are featured in their rotating exhibits throughout the museum, seven days a week.

Sarasota Jungle Gardens

One of the oldest continuously operating attractions in Florida, Sarasota Jungle Gardens evokes memories of Florida days gone by, full of flora, fauna and fun, yet remains current and exciting for today's families, locals, and tourists alike. A wide variety of birds and animals – many of them rescued – includes Florida's noted pink flamingos, parrots, crocodiles, lemurs, snakes and more. All nestled within 10 acres of lush, tropical landscaping connected by winding jungle trails. It's one of the only places you can walk up to and feed free roaming flamingos.

Solomon's Castle

Hidden in the lush Florida woodlands in one man's dream of a paradise. A visit to Solomon's Castle may be the most unique experience of your life! The home, galleries and workshop of internationally renowned artist Howard Solomon are open to the public.
