

Bible Mystery #32:






Bible Mystery #34:


Clue: 1 Samuel 17:36-37

"Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear; this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, because he has defied the armies of the living God. The Lord who delivered me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine."



Bible Mystery #35:

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! These problems are like labyrinths. King David had a huge and unfair problem. He had just slain the giant Goliath. He was supposed to be crowned king, according to the famous prophet Samuel. However, the current king was jealous. After David risked his life, King Saul tried to have him killed! He had to run and hide in caves. He had faithful men with him. Some say David was on the run for 15 years! Follow David on his journey from teenager who killed a giant to the king who was finally crowned 15 years later.

## 1 Samuel 17:45-50

David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.

"This day the Lord will hand you over to me and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. Today I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord's, and he will give all of you into our hands."

As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him. Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The stone sank into his forehead and he fell facedown on the ground.

So David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand he struck down the Philistine and killed him.
