

2021 FALL INTERNSHIP KIDS MINISTRY



The purpose of this internship is to offer hands-on ministry experience through opportunities to lead, serve, and learn alongside the Kids Pastor and staff at Ross Road Community Church (RRCC). The Ross Road Kids intern will assist in providing faith-based activities and lessons for Kids Worship on Sunday mornings and Awana on Wednesday nights.

Job Description

The intern in this position will be given substantial opportunity to lead and teach children, particularly those in elementary school. The intern will also lead and serve alongside volunteers. Additionally, the intern will perform a variety of functions appropriate to kids ministry needs and his or her own skill set. These may include:

- selecting, prepping, and leading small group activities to reinforce large group lessons
- assisting with worship and the arts as it relates to kids ministry
- preparing and giving the large group lesson in Kids Worship and/or Awana
- contributing to the planning and production of Faith@Home video lessons
- assisting with social media communications
- other administrative tasks and general duties as assigned

This position is for 10 hours per week for eleven weeks in the fall of 2021. An early September start date is preferred. The pay rate is \$15.20 per hour.

Supervision & Mentoring

The intern will experience a close mentoring relationship with the Kids Pastor from whom oversight is received. Additionally, the intern will be a member of the larger staff team, interacting with other pastors and staff members on a regular basis. The intern will have ample opportunity to serve and learn communication, interpersonal, and leadership skills, within the ministry context.

Eligibility, Qualifications and Training

- must be a born again Christian able to lead by example and who experiences a healthy relationship with God and others
- must be warm-hearted, committed, and dedicated, with a desire to serve
- must be in firm agreement with our Mennonite Brethren Confession of Faith
- must make RRCC his/her home church for the duration of employment
- must be legally entitled to work per the relevant provincial regulations
- preference will be given to candidates who have volunteered in Ross Road Kids, are exploring a career in ministry, or are pursuing an education degree
