# MATTHEW 21:1-11

## WHAT WERE THEY LOOKING FOR?

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.

I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the horse from Jerusalem; The battle bow shall be cut off. He shall speak peace to the nations; His dominion shall be 'from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth.' Zechariah 9:9-10 MORE LIKE JESUS

### They were looking for a King to bring peace and dominion

### What did they see?

#### 1. He rode in on a donkey.

- Horses signified war while donkeys meant peace
- Kings and princes rode in on donkeys
- Jerusalem was their capital; Jesus rode into town MORE LIKE JESUS

## 2. Hosanna to the Son of David

- Acknowledged who He was (5x); genealogy
- Hosanna save us now; save,
  I beseech thee

# What did they not see?

#### Who is this?

- The town of Jerusalem had no idea who He was.
- They were moved only by the excitement
- But they wanted to know more

### The Jews response

- A. He is a prophet
  - that's all He is?
- What a missed opportunity!
  - B. Why not 'Our King'?!
    - The Messiah
- The one we have been waiting for!

  MORE LIKE JESUS

# They couldn't see the forest for the trees.

The people missed what was meant to be seen because they only saw what they wanted to see.
