Encouragement

- One another – 1 Thessalonians 5:11
- From the Scriptures – Romans 15:4
- Depending upon God – Romans 15:5

- Hebrews 10:19-25 – one long sentence

The Foundation for Encouragement – what God has done (Hebrews 10:19-20)

- The assurance of our salvation gives us every reason to encourage

The Momentum of Encouragement – hope (Hebrews 10:23)

The Action of Encouragement – spurring one another to love and good deeds (Hebrews 10:24)
