THE ORDER OF ST GEORGE**

On Friday, August 20 at a ceremony at the Cathedral of St George, Kingston's own Dr Kieran Michael Moore MD, CCFP(EM) FCFP, MPH, DTM&H, FRCPC Ontario Chief Medical Officer of Health, will be recognized as a Field Knight of the Order of St George.



The Order of St George is a chivalric Order supporting members of the Canadian Armed Forces, Veterans and and their families as well as cadets. It is regionally organized across Canada by Priory.

A Field Knight of the Order is a special honour reserved for individuals who are not members of the Order but who have had a great impact on the constituency the Order supports. The members of the Kingston Priory choose to honour Dr Moore as a Field Knight for his extraordinary and innovative contribution to the health of all Ontarians in his capacity as the Chief Medical Officer of Health for Kingston Frontenac Lennox and Addington and now for the entire province.

The event will be held at 1030 AM and will be followed by a short reception. In attendance will be Knights and Dames of the Kingston Priory as well as colleagues of Dr Moore. Due to limitations of space the event will not be open to the public; however the Kingston Priory hopes that all may join in spirit to honour this worthy gentleman.
