

The government has given final approval to the Pfizer vaccine. As a result, the government is asking businesses to mandate to their employees that they get a Covid vaccine. I know some of you are extremely bothered by the constitutionality of this mandate and doubt the efficacy of the shots. And those thoughts are completely up to you. It is not my desire to sway you one way or the other. I just hope that you have spent time in prayer, and you are asking the Lord for wisdom. If you are one of those individuals that oppose the Covid vaccine (or the mandatory effort by the government), I do have copies of a religious exemption form in the foyer. I cannot guarantee your company will accept it. We are just making the form available to you. FOR-US (Freedom of Religion-United Solutions) has a lot of helpful information about this exemption form on their website, forunitedsolutions.org. Just in case you didn't know, the Supreme Court heard a similar case in 1905 like what we are facing today. Early in the 20th century, the government started mandating the citizens take a smallpox vaccine. In *Jacobson vs. Massachusetts*, the court ruled in favor of Massachusetts. The justices felt that the police power of a state absolutely included reasonable regulations established by legislature to protect public health and safety. The court said that if the Board of Health felt it was necessary for public health, then it could be mandated by the government. Church family, there is a season for everything. But we know our God is sovereign and his eschatological plan is right on track. We know our Redeemer lives and is coming back to take the church home. Until then, let's live for the King and sound the trumpet. There is hope in Jesus Christ!

Dear Friends,

In May, I (Stephen) asked for prayer regarding the Covid situation in Brazil and our preparations to move to Rio de Janeiro. We were very hopeful that this would be the year that we would be moving to Brazil, but it looks like we will have to postpone our plans until 2022. While the Covid situation in the United States and Israel has improved significantly, there are still many countries that are struggling, and Israel has banned their citizens from visiting some of these countries. Brazil is one of these countries, which means that there will be no Israelis in Brazil this year when we were planning to open the guesthouse for its first season.



Our plan to reach Israelis in Brazil with the guesthouse is still our long-term goal, but we have had to shift gears a bit until we can go there next year. As we were talking with our boss about different options of reaching Israelis in 2021, he asked us what we would like to do. We quickly responded, "We want to go where Israelis are." He grinned and said, "You know there is only one place where you are guaranteed to meet Israelis: Israel." After spending some time in prayer over this decision, we feel directed to go to Israel for about five months starting this fall.

In Israel, we will be working with other Chosen People Ministries staff in Tel Aviv. We will be able to reach Israelis through the many different programs that they are doing at their Messianic center, such as English classes and Shabbat dinners. We will also be able to learn the language and culture. When Jewish people become citizens of Israel, they take Hebrew classes to help them learn the language. We will be taking these classes along with them, which will help us learn Hebrew and give us opportunities to meet people with whom we can share the gospel.

Please be praying for us as we make preparations for Israel this fall. Pray that we find the right housing and make good connections that will lead to Jewish people coming to faith. Please also pray that the Covid situation in Brazil would improve and lives would be spared. God is faithful to lead us and sustain us even through Covid changing our plans numerous times.
