




Education resumes Sunday, September 12 in Tempe & Gilbert


What Can I Depend On?




Book Group Returns! Two Old Women: An Alaska Legend of Betrayal, Courage, and Survival

The items you choose to donate may be new or "gently used" and in ALL sizes and colors.



Desert Cross has been feeding the homeless at Grace Lutheran Church since 1999. We took a


